

PROGRAM & BROADCAST REQUIREMENTS

- The live broadcast will begin at **12:00 pm EST**. The outline of the program will be:
 - 12:00 pm: Final 15 Minutes of the Hachnasat Sefer Torah Procession -Live interviews with guests (in English).
 - 12:15 pm: 'One People - One Heart - One Voice' Presentation
 - 12:30 pm: Conclusion of the Worldwide Learning Initiative
- The broadcast will be appropriate for English and Hebrew speakers.
- The broadcast will be accessible through the Internet on the day of the event. *Anyone* can access the broadcast through our website, www.BlevEchad.com by clicking a 'VIEW' tab. No login/password will be required.
- Once you access the broadcast, you will be able to make it full screen and project it to your audience.
- In order for you to show the broadcast, please make sure you meet the following basic requirements. A detailed chart is provided below:
 - ✓ For optimal performance, computers should be plugged into the Internet via an Ethernet connection. Wireless connections also work. Make sure your Internet connectivity is 400 kbps DSL, 500 kbps Cable Modem, or faster.
 - ✓ Most computers or laptops should suffice. The system requirements are minimal and a computer less than three years old should work.
 - ✓ For optimal viewing, we recommend that you connect your computer or laptop to a projector and sound system.
 - ✓ If using a projector, be sure to set it up in a well-ventilated area so that it does not overheat. An overheated projector can shut off mid-broadcast.
